TWO or more seals are required for graduation. At least ONE seal must be a state defined seal.

	State-Defined Diploma Seals	Requirements
	Military Enlistment Seal	Provide evidence that a student has enlisted in a branch of the U.S. Armed Force; or Participate in an approved JROTC program.
	Technology Seal	A student can: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exam; 2. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus Program; or 3. Complete a course offered through the district or school that meets guidelines developed by the Department. (A district or school is not required to offer a course that meets those guidelines)
	Industry-Recognized Credential Seal	Earn a 12-point approved industry-recognized credential or group of credentials totaling 12 points in a single career field.
	Citizenship Seal	A student can: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Earn a score of proficient (3) or higher on both the American history and American government end-of-course exams; 2. Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams; or 3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in appropriate classes taken through the College Credit Plus program.
	Ohio Means Jobs - Readiness Seal	Meet the requirements and criteria established for the readiness seal, including demonstration of work-readiness and professional competencies.
	State Seal of Biliteracy	Meet the requirements and criteria, including proficiency requirements on assessments in a world language and English.
	College-Ready Seal	Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT. Visit the Department’s website to see current remediation-free scores .

	<p>Science Seal</p>	<p>A student can:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Earn a score of proficient (3) or higher on the biology end-of-course exam; 2. Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams; or 3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus program.
	<p>Honors Diploma Seal</p>	<p>Earn one of six Honors Diplomas outlined below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Academic Honors Diploma 2. International Baccalaureate Honors Diploma 3. Career-Tech Honors Diploma 4. STEM Honors Diploma 5. Arts Honors Diploma 6. Social Science and Civic Engagement Honors Diploma

	<p>Locally-Defined Diploma Seals</p>	<p>Requirements</p>
	<p>Community Service Seal</p>	<p>40 hours of community service. It is recommended that students meet this by completing 10 hours each year of high school. A verification letter will include the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student’s name 2. Date(s) of completion, location and description of service and how many hours (no less than 5) were satisfactorily completed 3. Name, signature and contact information (email address and phone number) of an adult (non-family) supervising the service. 4. Students pursuing this seal will track their own hours and obtain verification letters 5. Completed service hour letters are due by May 1st of the student’s senior year
	<p>Fine & Performing Arts Seal</p>	<p>2 high school credits in the fine and/or performing arts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See the courses under the Art and Music section in the course selection guide for a list of credits that count for this seal • Note that some courses are .5 credit
	<p>Student Engagement Seal</p>	<p>Active participation in at least 4 Orrville High School extracurricular activities spanning at least 2 school years</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extracurricular activities include clubs, sports, leadership groups for which the student does NOT earn academic credit (except Marching Band) • Participation is described as a minimum of 80% attendance, active involvement, and completion of the activity’s duration • Students pursuing this seal must obtain signatures from the activity’s advisor or coach as verification of active participation
