Kelly Chandler of 1844 Wayne St., works in a district that requires masks and she is in favor of masking. She wants kids in school.

Dan Ciammaichella of 7483 Dalton Fox Lake, experts are telling us to do the same thing as 19 months ago when COVID cases have gone up and down. He is opposed to masking students.

Emmalia Chandler of 1844 Wayne St., is a student at Orrville High School. She stated that she had a hard time with distance / online learning; kids wants to be in school.

Amber Beichler of 3131 York Rd., stated parents should have the choice to mask their students or not.

Saundra Kolar of 13571 Forrest Dr. said everyone wants kids in school and to be safe. She is in favor of staying safe with a mask.

Tom Brenner of 10666 Yoder Rd., asked why require health initiatives when it's the parent's job. He wants parents to decide what is best for their children.

Elizabeth Wallace of 145 S Crown Hill, said Orrville has values and what it means to be an Orrville resident. She was in favor of extending the mask requirement.

Damien (no last name given) of Cuyahoga Falls, senior at Cuyahoga Falls High School; said it was his body, his choice.

Vicki Prunty of 130 Pearl St., shared her experiences that masking works and she doesn't want to give someone Covid.

Aaron Shultzman of 2020 Sunnyview Lane, stated masks don't work. He wants kids and parents to have the choice to wear or not wear masks. He appreciated the Board's concerns.

Jodi Rice of 2140 Championship Circle SE, stated the Education Association of Orrville conducted a survey. The results of the survey are as follows: 73% of the teachers responding wanted masks in the classrooms. The responding teachers also indicated that remote learning negatively impacts student learning.

Jill Miller of 16469 Hanover, pray for wisdom, keep kids at school; against taking choice away from parents; masks are a distraction.

Monica Miyashita of 847 S. Vine St., gave a top ten list why mask requirements should be continued.

Rashel Kissel of 1590 N Crown Hill, kids are not affected by Covid like adults are; masks don't totally prevent Covid.

Megan Middleton of 2529 E. Paradise Ext., spoke in support of continuation of mask regiments.
