



Religious or Philosophical Exemption Form

Amended Substitute Senate Bill N. 282
Ohio Revised Code, Sections 3313.67 and 3313.671

Sec. 3313.671 (5) A child whose physician certifies in writing that such immunization against any disease is medically contraindicated is not required to be immunized against that disease.

This section does not limit or impair the right of a board of education of city, exempted village, or local school district to make and enforce rules to secure immunization against poliomyelitis, rubella, mumps, measles, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, hepatitis B and varicella of the pupils under jurisdiction.
