- 5. 7:30-10:00–Prom at the White Oak

Prom promises to be a fun evening, but please remember these guidelines to ensure that you have the best time possible:

- 1. All those attending must be a senior or junior.
- A senior or junior may invite a sophomore or freshman to prom provided that a) the underclassman has the enclosed permission slip signed by a parent, and b) they are an OHS student. UNDERCLASSMEN FROM OTHER SCHOOLS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.
- 3. You may invite a junior or senior from another high school, provided that the enclosed permission slip is filled out by the administration of their school. Your guest must have ID to be admitted to prom. If your guest has already graduated, only Orrville alumni will be allowed entrance.
- 4. No one over 20 will be allowed in.
- 5. This is a school sponsored function. All rules and policies will apply in order to maintain a safe and healthy environment. Additionally, to ensure the safety of all attendees, local law enforcement will be on premises.
- 6. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES, UNLESS PICKED UP BY A PARENT.

Prom tickets will go on sale April 7, 2025, before school in Mrs. Coleman's room, and during lunch. Last day of sales will be April 25, 2025. Dinner will again be served at Prom but ticket prices will remain \$45/person, or \$80/couple. This helps make the evening more safe and enjoyable.
