Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee case management for students' Mental Health Support Plans, ensuring timely development, implementation, and monitoring.
- Collaborate with school staff, families, and external agencies to coordinate social service supports tailored to student and family needs.
- Collect Student case data for the District Mental Health Specialist
- Facilitate communication between educators, counselors, parents, and community organizations to ensure cohesive support systems.
- Advocate for students and families, ensuring access to community resources such as counseling, housing, or food assistance
